EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Over the past few years, we have consistently demonstrated the immense potential of Bitcoin as a solution to Africa's persistent economic challenges. In a continent grappling with currency volatility, inflation, and exclusion from traditional financial systems, Bitcoin offers a lifeline, ensuring financial inclusion, stability, and economic opportunities. The Africa Bitcoin Conference has become the leading platform for showcasing how Bitcoin's decentralized architecture, borderless nature, and low transaction costs empower Africans to access banking services, facilitate cross-border trade, and secure their financial futures independently of traditional financial institutions.

Since its inception in 2022, the Africa Bitcoin Conference has established itself as a significant event in Africa's financial landscape. The conference has brought together stakeholders, visionaries, and Bitcoin enthusiasts to explore and harness the potential of Bitcoin to drive economic growth and foster financial inclusion across the continent. While the first two editions in Accra, Ghana, laid a strong foundation, the 2024 conference in Nairobi, Kenya, marked a significant milestone, achieving unprecedented levels of participation and impact.

The ripple effects of the conference have been profound, accelerating the growth of Africa's Bitcoin ecosystem. In just two years, the number of Bitcoin-related projects, products, and companies on the continent has surged from fewer than 30 in 2022 to over 120 by 2024. These initiatives span critical sectors such as mining, retail, education, media, events, community building, and nonprofits, impacting more than 30 countries across Africa.

Beyond showcasing innovation, the conference has emerged as a vital incubator for partnerships and collaborations, enabling numerous projects to secure crucial funding and strategic alliances through its dynamic network. This remarkable growth shows how important the Africa Bitcoin Conference has been in building a strong Bitcoin community that is improving financial access and creating new opportunities across the continent.

This impact report provides a comprehensive assessment of the 2024 Africa Bitcoin Conference and its associated initiatives. It highlights the activities and outcomes that have propelled Africa's Bitcoin ecosystem forward, fostering innovation, inclusivity, and resilience in the year under review.

Attendees ranged from developers, entrepreneurs, policymakers, academics, and Bitcoin enthusiasts from over 30 countries.








05 SPEAKERS

06. KEY HIGHLIGHTS


The conference featured key impact stories showcasing how Bitcoin has transformed lives and businesses across the continent.

HACKATHON

Block, Inc, the global technology company with a focus on financial services announced the winners of the highly anticipated TBD Hackathon, at the conference. The competition was designed to foster innovation, creativity, and technological advancements in payments across Africa.

Participants in the hackathon tackled crucial challenges, including limited access to banking, high transaction fees, and inefficient cross-border payments. Each team made up of 1-2 developers, used the tbDEX SDK to build their payment applications within a sandbox environment.


The grand prize winner, Emmanuel Kufre, developed Blink, a decentralized wallet application designed to streamline payment processing for freelancers. He was awarded \$15,000 in BTC for his innovation. Other notable winners included tbDEX Go and Igbigi, which secured \$10,000 and \$5,000 in BTC, respectively.



ABC SOCIAL IMPACT AWARD

The inaugural ABC Social Impact Award was announced, celebrating individuals and organisations leveraging Bitcoin for social good. This award is not just about innovation in finance; it is about using Bitcoin as a tool for creating a positive, lasting impact in areas such as Financial Inclusion, Education & Awareness, Economic Empowerment, Humanitarian Efforts and Social Justice & Freedom.

After public nominations, an expert panel selected 10 projects as finalists for the award. In addition to the prize monies, all nominees received money raised from the voting process to support their works across the continent. After public voting, three projects emerged as winners and were awarded on the main stage at the conference.

The conference provided the ground for a lot of networking activities. These events allowed bitcoiners to connect and have meaningful discussions.





FEDI LOUNGE

In partnership with Fedi, we created a dedicated lounge which created an environment for conference participants to relax, recharge, and connect in a more informal setting. This public lounge provided an engaging environment for playful interactions, casual conversations, and spontaneous connections among attendees, fostering a relaxed atmosphere for networking







BTRUST ANNOUNCES GRANT RECIPIENTS

Btrust announced recipients of the Q1 funding for 2025. This grant program sets the stage for engineers to contribute meaningfully, build credibility, and find direction through sustained contributions to open-source projects without worrying about livelihood.

KENYA FIRE BRIGADES ASSOCIATION BECOMES FIRST AFRICAN LABOR UNION TO HOLD BITCOIN

The Kenya National Fire Brigades Association (KENFIBA) has made history as the first labor union in Kenya and across Africa to adopt Bitcoin.

This milestone was achieved through a "Get Off Zero" donation facilitated by Proof of Workforce, a nonprofit organization dedicated to helping unions and workers integrate Bitcoin into their financial systems.


The announcement was made on December 11 during the Africa Bitcoin Conference in Nairobi.




7 AFROBITCOIN FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME


Launched in 2022, the fellowship programme continues to support developers from Africa by providing them with mentorship and access to opportunities.



FINANCIAL LITERACY SUMMER CAMP

The Africa Bitcoin Community (ABC) successfully hosted a Financial Literacy Summer Camp at the Accra Technical Training Centre (ATTC), which brought together 50 students.

Over four interactive sessions, teens and high school students were equipped with essential financial skills to help them achieve financial independence. Through hands-on workshops and practical exercises, participants gained a deeper understanding of financial literacy, empowering them to make informed financial decisions for the future.

ABC 2025

ABC POLICY FORUM
